The policies stated in this handbook were carefully reviewed and agreed upon by the Board so that all members will have a positive Club experience. Club manager has the prerogative to interpret the rules & regulations as they will benefit all the members.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Membership

- **Permanent Memberships** (includes ownership and voting rights) may be obtained directly from the Club or by transfer. Memberships may be purchased from the Club for a \$500 initiation fee plus \$500 annual dues. Transfer memberships purchased outside the Club are subject to a \$150 transfer fee plus \$500 annual dues. Before purchasing a transfer membership, confirm that the membership is in good standing with the membership chair.
- **Temporary Memberships (no ownership or voting rights) may be obtained from the Club for an annual fee of \$625.** One hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125) of the annual fee, each year, may be applied to the purchase of a permanent membership. At the end of 5 years, the Temporary Membership will become Permanent. If a member purchases a transfer membership from another member, in the second year of their ownership, **and second year only**, \$125 of their first years' dues will be applied towards the \$150 transfer fee.
- **Adult Memberships (no ownership, voting rights or transferability - unless original Permanent Membership still held) may be obtained from the Club for an annual fee of \$225.** All children in the household must be 16 years of age or older, by June 1 of each year. No complimentary guest passes will be issued, but members may bring guests in for the normal fee or purchase a guest card. Club guest rules apply to Adult memberships. Adult membership age is 21. All children of adult members must pay guest fee when using Club (guest rules apply to children of adult members). This membership is on a year-to-year basis.
- **Inactive Memberships (no usage of Club facilities) may be maintained for \$175.**
- **Annual dues are payable in full according to the schedule below.** Dues should be sent to the Club's mailing address. Payment will be credited based on the **postmark date**. Dues not paid by June 15th will result in forfeiture of the membership.

Entrance Policy/Age Requirements

- **Notwithstanding the presence of any personnel affiliated with the Club, (including but not limited to lifeguards, pool attendants, coaches or professionals), all persons, whether members, non-members granted access for particular programs, guests and others, using the Club and any of its facilities are responsible for their own safety and shall be deemed to have assumed the risk of using the Club and any of its facilities. Further, all persons, agree that the Club, its owner, Club management, officers, employees, affiliates, representatives and agents, shall not be held liable for any loss, injury or death arising out of the use of the Club and any of its facilities or presence on the Club premise.**
- **All members, age 6 and older, must be listed on the master registration list, which will be kept at the entrance table at the Club.** All members must check in each time they come to the Club. Photos and additional information will be kept in a master file for identification purposes. Families must register their nannies or babysitters in the master file. Registration Day is usually the third Sunday in May from 10 AM – 2 PM. Late dues can be paid and photos taken at this time. Entrance to the Club will be strictly monitored. Individuals not on the master list will not be allowed entrance to the Club.
- **Age requirements.** Children must be 10 years of age by June 1st of that year to use the club unsupervised. Children under the age of 10 years of age require supervision by a parent or guardian. Children must be at least 12 years old to baby-sit younger children.

2008 Guest Policy

- **Guests of the Club are any nonmembers over the age of one year, whether Foxridge residents or not.** All guests will be asked to sign a guest form and pay the \$5 guest fee, if applicable. An individual may be a guest of the club ***no more than four times a calendar year*** unless prior arrangements are made with the Club manager. This applies to all levels of membership: permanent, temporary and adult.
- **Each Permanent and Temporary Membership will be issued one guest card with 20 punches** (a \$100 value). Guest cards are valid only during the year of issue. Additional cards with six punches may be purchased for \$22.50 (a \$30 value). Single guest admissions may be purchased at the gate for \$5 per guest. Out-of-town guests and family members (i.e. grandparents) not swimming or playing tennis are admitted free.
- Members bringing a large group of guests to the Club for a special event (i.e. a birthday party, etc.), during the day, should refer to the “Private Party Policy” in the back section of this handbook.
- **Events and Guest Fees: Guest Fee \$7-Adult, \$5-Child**
Please Note: Fourth of July - No Guest Passes Allowed, Fees Apply

Tennis Courts are available year round (with a key) and open during Club Hours. Please check the Tennis Section for court availability after Adult and Junior Tennis practices and lessons.

Your club management and Board reserve the right to change hours in case of weather, and to insure the most effective use of the facilities.

* The pool will not be open until approx. 1:30 PM on Saturday, June 21st, 28th and July 12th due to home swim meets and until 1:30 PM on Wednesday, July 16th for the league prelims.

** Because the Cherry Creek School District will still be in session through June 3rd, swim team practice will be held in the mornings and evenings from May 27th through June 3rd.

Note: The pool will be closed @ 7 PM on Friday July 4th, at 5 PM on Sunday, July 27 for the Swim Team Banquet at 7 PM on Saturday, August 9 for the Junior Tennis Team Banquet.

SWIMMING

Adult Swim - Open swim

- **Adult swim is reserved for adults' age eighteen years of age and older.** During open swim hours, the last ten minutes of each hour is reserved for adult swim. During this time a child under the age of seven may accompany an adult into the pool. The adult must be with the child in the pool. Only one (1) child per adult.
- **Parent or adult supervision is required, at all times, when using the baby pool or the shallow end of the main pool.** Use of the baby pool is intended for children **age five and under**. Approved, plastic diapers with snug fitting elastic waist and leg bands must be worn when the children are in the water.

- **Children under 13 years of age will not be allowed to swim in the deep end of the pool without a parent or adult unless they can pass the Swim and Safety Test.** This test consists of proving their ability to swim the width of the pool.
- **Early morning adult lap swim is on Monday, Wednesday & Fridays from 6–7 AM.** Check at the pool after opening weekend for starting dates. (Weather Permitting).

Swimming Lessons

- **The Foxridge Swim & Racquet Club will be offering swim lessons for all ages and abilities this summer. This is a 10 level program. Each succeeding level is designed to build upon the skills learned from the previous level. When each level is successfully completed, the swimmer will have learned a unique style of swimming. Each level has a set of skills to be learned that lead to an advancement goal.**
- **At registration, there will be additional information available which will specify all the prerequisites for each level. This will better assist you in determining class selection.**
- **Four sessions of swim lessons will be offered:**

- Each session offers eight, separate 30 minute classes held over a 2 week period. They will be held Monday through Thursday of each week with Fridays reserved for make-up classes. Fridays are reserved only if a class was canceled, not if a participant missed a class. There are eight class periods per class per session. Lesson times for each session are as follows:

Morning classes: 10:00-10:30 AM
10:30-11:00 AM
11:00-11:30 AM (if needed, depends on # of registered)

- Unless events at the pool require a different day, member registration for each session will open on the Monday two weeks before the start of the session. This can be done at the pool during regular pool hours. Registration for non-members will open Monday, one week prior to the session. Registration will close at the start of each session or when classes are full. Please note that not all classes will be available at all times. All classes require a minimum of three participants and are held to a maximum of six. The registration book will contain any information you may require about the classes. It will also specify prerequisites for each class level to better assist you in class selection for your children. Instructors can answer any additional questions. Refunds will be in full if cancellation occurs on or before the Friday prior to the start of the session. Refunds will not be given after this time.

- **Member’s fees for each session are \$40.00 for the first child and \$35.00 for each additional child in the same session.** Non-member’s fees will be \$60.00 for the first child and \$55 for each additional in the same session.

- Private and semi-private lessons will be available at the Club through approved instructors. Only FSRC employees who are CPR certified will be allowed to give private lessons. The fee for private lessons is \$17.00 for one half-hour lesson and \$24.00 (for 2 participants, maximum) for one, half hour semi-private lesson. For non-members the fee is \$20 for one half-hour lesson and \$30 (for 2 participants maximum) for one half-hour semi-private lesson. All private lessons & scheduling are coordinated through the Club Manager.

SWIM TEAM

The Foxridge Swim Team competes in Division A of the Mountain Hi Swim League and is open to any swimmer age 18 and under. A child must be able to swim the length of the pool to participate. The head coaches are **Elise Krumholz and Jessica Dawkins** and the assistant coaches are **Scott Dawkins, Hannah Sanek, and Chrissy Homsher**.

- **Registration fees (due by the first practice each year) are \$100 for the first child and \$90 for each additional child for FSRC members. Membership must be in good standing at time of registration in order to receive discounted Member rates. Non-member fees are \$140 per child.** Mountain Hi Swim League is a volunteer run league and must have parent support in order to be successful. **Each meet** requires between 50 and 60 volunteers. The Foxridge Swim Team also requires each family to provide a \$75 deposit as a *Volunteer Fee*. Each family must provide a parent volunteer to help, at least 4 times, in some capacity, during the swim season. The deposit will be returned to you at the end of the season if four volunteer sessions have been completed. If you are unable to complete your commitment, you will forfeit the return of your fee. A swimmer will not be allowed to practice or participate in a meet until registration and volunteer fees are paid (insurance regulations and team policy).

- **In addition, each family is asked provide a 24 pack of 16-20 oz bottled water, Gatorade** or Powerade sports drink, or Coke/Pepsi Products **and** a food item to be sold at the home meets. The Foxridge swim team hosts a concession stand at each home meet. This is the team’s largest and most effective fundraiser. The money raised by the concession stand is used to purchase banquet supplies, pep-rally donuts and drinks, pay the coaches, and helps defray the cost of meet supplies such as ribbons and medals, labels, paper, toner, etc. Be sure to mark your drink donation with your swimmers name. Sign-up sheets for food items will be posted the week prior to home meets with specific food item donations needed such as pancake mix, muffins, fruit, etc. Your donations are what make our concession stand so successful!

- **Swim Suits and Gear:** Foxridge is on a two-year program with a new suit in even years. The team suit is selected by the volunteer youth/parent committee. Any family can be on that committee. The Foxridge team colors are black and red. This is the 1st year for our 2 year team suits. We provide each swimmer with a Foxridge Swim Team T-shirt, and if they want one, a Foxridge Swim cap. Additional t-shirts can be purchased from a Parent Rep. There are also a limited number of silicone swim caps available for purchase.

TENNIS

Court Reservations/Gate Keys

- **Tennis courts may be reserved two days in advance.** A court sign-up notebook will be found at the guard table or the snack bar. Junior Team tennis has priority on the courts Monday from 8:30 – 2:30, mid-June through the end of July, for League play. Remember that from mid-May through mid-July, the adult USTA Evening Leagues have the courts from 5 p.m. until dark Mondays through Thursdays. Team practices are on Saturday mornings & afternoons. The courts will be open to members at all other times. During Club hours, players must enter the tennis courts through the main Club gate and check in at the front desk. Fees for tennis guests are \$5. Each member's tennis gate key will unlock the parking lot tennis gate and the upper tennis gate for play before and after hours. Proper footwear must be worn at all times! No black-soled shoes will be permitted at any time! Tennis etiquette must be observed. Respect the courts and the rights of others who might be playing at the same time. Please no food or drink on the courts, and please bring a can or plastic for your favorite beverage.

Tennis Lessons

- **Tennis lessons, with the Foxridge tennis professional, Dave Chover, are available for all levels of expertise.** You can contact Dave at tennisprodave4@aol.com or at tennispro@foxridgeclub.com. 24 hour notice should be given to cancel any lesson.

Junior Tennis Socials and Activities

Junior tennis will have several social opportunities during the 2008 season. Tennis activities are open to both team members and lessons participants.

- Junior Tennis Olympiad will be held on July 13th.
- We will co-host a trip to the Pirate’s Cove with the swim team so all the junior athletes at the club will have a chance to come together and celebrate the end of another fun summer at Foxridge.

Our Club is a great place to hang-out and play tennis. But we want to make sure that everyone knows and understands the rules of using our tennis courts and what is expected of you as a player. Please read through the following rules and if you have any questions about them, ask your parents, the tennis pro, or one of the Junior Representatives. Make sure you understand these rules. (By the way, the adults have to live by these rules, too.)

These rules are for all participants of the Foxridge tennis program, their guests and other guests of the club.

- 1) Treat everyone with **respect**.
- 2) Follow the rules of tennis **etiquette** (we will go over these at the beginning of the season if you have any questions about it) and the USTA rules posted at the entrance of the courts.
- 3) Tennis is a game that requires concentration. Please **do not be loud** or distracting to others who are playing while you are on or around the courts.
- 4) **Tennis shoes** are required at all times. Shoes that have scuffing soles or black soles are not allowed at any time on the courts.
- 5) **Tennis attire** should be worn. If you have a bathing suit on, you must wear a shirt, too (even girls). Dripping wet bathing suits are not allowed.
- 6) You **may not damage** or mark the courts in any way. This means, don't hit your racquet on the court, throw your racquet, or draw, mark-up, or etch into the court surface with anything.
- 7) You **may not climb on the fencing** surrounding the courts. **Don't pull or hang on the net** or damage the net in any way.
- 8) Absolutely **nothing with wheels** is allowed on the courts at any time. No bikes, skateboards, hee-ee-type shoes, scooters, roller-blades/skates etc.
- 9) **No food or gum** on the courts (except for energy bars).
- 10) Water and Gatorade-type drinks are the **only** drinks allowed on the courts. **No soda** on the courts. Any drinks must be in either cans or plastic containers. (Glass containers are not allowed anywhere at the club.)
- 11) **Pick-up after yourself**. Don't leave any trash behind.
- 12) You must be at least **10 years old** to play on the courts without an adult's supervision.
- 13) If you are going to have a **guest** play with you, you must check them in at the front desk before you start playing. Fees for tennis guests are \$5.00.
- 14) You **may reserve a court** up to 48 hours in advance. Reservation book is at the table at the entrance of the club.
- 15) **USTA league play has priority** over any other play. Please know that from May through July all four courts are used Mondays through Thursdays from 5p.m. to dark by adult leagues. Check the book however, because we may have an away match and the courts may be available. Additionally, the adults practice every Saturday (approx. 8:30-4:00pm), and two courts will be used by those practices each Saturday.
- 16) If you have reserved the court, or are playing on a court that no one else has reserved, you have the right to play there. However, if you are on the court but not really playing tennis, or just "playing around," you will be expected to **step off the court** and allow others to use it for tennis play.

Club Amenities

Concession Stand, Ice Machine and Barbecue Grills

- The **concession stand is open during posted hours**. Please check schedule for exact times, as they vary during the season. Concession stand vouchers can be purchased for \$10.
- **Ice is free**. A supply of ice cubes is always available in the large cooler which sits under the big tent.
- **Gas barbecue grills are available for members use at no charges**. Please let one of the lifeguards know you would like to use one and they will help you. Members are responsible for cleaning grills following use.

Facility Rentals

- The **Club facility is available for small parties, no more than two on any given day, during pool operating hours**. Parties during pool hours should be scheduled at least one week prior to the party date. Please obtain party form from pool management. There will not be a flat fee charge for members with groups no larger than 15 people. Normal guest fees apply.
- **An application** for small parties must be completed & returned to the manager along with a \$25 “cleanup deposit”, which will be returned if no guard cleanup is needed. No more than 2 small parties will be allowed on any given day, at the discretion of the manager. These parties must not interfere with the enjoyment of the Club by other members.
- Large parties (over 15 people) **will not** be able to reserve the Club during regular pool hours. **The Club is available, for rental for large parties, after pool hours.**

Private Party Policy (after hours)

- Reservations must be made **2 weeks in advance**, with a 24-hour cancellation policy.
- An application form must be picked up at the pool or downloaded from the club’s website (foxridgeclub.com), filled out completely and returned with a check. No date can be reserved without the paperwork & checks being turned in.

Rental fees are: (flat fee schedule)

21-40 people - \$100	41-60 people - \$125	61-90 people - \$175
91-120 people - \$225	121-150 people - \$275 (maximum limit 150)	

- In addition to the above, a \$16/hour lifeguard charge will be assessed. The number of guards will be determined based on the size of the group. There is a two guard minimum.
- A \$100 damage deposit will be required for groups of 25 or more. This will be returned within 24 hours providing there has been no damage to the facility or excessive cleanup required by guards.
- If alcohol will be served or consumed on the premises, the member in charge must return, with the application, a certificate of liability insurance.
- Teen or young adult parties must be supervised. One adult for every 6 kids.
- Please see foxridgeclub.com for party agreement form.

***Note:** Improvement Association covenants require that parties conclude at 10:30 PM weekdays, 11 PM weekends.

FOXRIDGE SWIM & RACQUET CLUB

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following Rules and Regulations have been established to provide an efficient, safe and enjoyable facility for all members. Notwithstanding the presence of any personnel affiliated with the Club, (including but not limited to lifeguards, pool attendants, coaches or professionals), all persons, whether members, non-members granted access for particular programs, guests and others, using the Club and any of its facilities are responsible for their own safety and shall be deemed to have assumed the risk of using the Club and any of its facilities. Further, all persons, agree that the Club, its owner, Club management, officers, employees, affiliates, representatives and agents, shall not be held liable for any loss, injury or death arising out of the use of the Club and any of its facilities or presence on the Club premise.

GENERAL

1. Generally, open swim hours are from 11:00 AM to 8:00 PM on weekdays and from 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM on weekends.
2. Tennis gate keys are available – 1 per membership. Replacement keys will be issued for a charge determined annually.
3. Everyone is expected to comply with the safety rules posted within the Club area.
4. All members and their guests who use the Club do so at their own risk. The Club will not be responsible for any accidents or injuries in connection with such use.
5. The Club Manager or his designee has the authority, at his/her discretion, to ask anyone to leave the facility.
6. Persons observed climbing on the perimeter fences of the Club are subject to disciplinary action or expulsion. Members are asked to report any violations to the head lifeguard or Club Manager.
7. Bicycles must be parked in the bike racks. The Club is not responsible for theft. Under no circumstances will bicycles, skateboards or rollerblades be permitted within the fenced area of the Club.
8. The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen property. Members & guests are encouraged to lock their cars while they are at the Club.
9. A 'Lost and Found' will be provided. Goods, including lawn chairs, not claimed by mid-season or at the end of the season will be donated to charity.
10. Food or drink is not to be taken into the pool at any time.
11. **Glass containers will not be allowed anywhere within the Club.**
12. All members and their guests must pick up their own trash, when leaving the Club, and discard it in the proper trash receptacles.
13. No pets of any kind are allowed within the Club.
14. All members, six years and older, must be checked in at the front desk and compared to the photo ID on the members registration page. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- 14a. A "member" is defined as any family member, under the age of 16 living in the same house as the membership holder.
15. Anyone with a suggestion/complaint regarding the facility or activities may contact the Club Manager or a Board Member. Depending on the nature of the concern, you may be asked to attend the next board meeting for presentation and discussion of the item.

16. Unsupervised children: Children must be 10 years old by June 1st of that year to use the club unsupervised. Children under the age of 10 years of age require supervision by a parent, or guardian. If they are not old enough to stay at home without a baby-sitter, then they are not old enough to be at the pool unsupervised. Children must be at least 12 years old to baby-sit younger children.

17. Disruptive behavior by children may be handled by the FSRC staff with a warning, a call home to the parents and/or sending the child immediately home.

18. Foxridge is a non-smoking facility. Smoking is not permitted anywhere on Club property.

GUESTS

1. Guests of the Club are any non-member over the age of one year, whether Foxridge residents or not. An individual may be a guest of the Club no more than four times a calendar year, unless prior arrangements are made with the Club Manager. This also includes tennis guests.

2. Each member, at the beginning of each season, will be given 1 guest card with 20 complimentary passes on it. The card will be punched by the gate attendants when a guest is brought in. Any additional guest cards may be purchased for a charge determined annually.

3. Guests are subject to and must abide by the rules and regulations of the Club.

4. Members are responsible for their guests and any damages incurred by guests will result in assessment against the member.

5. Members wishing to make arrangement for full time baby-sitters/nannies under their membership may do so by contacting the Club Manager. A special card may be issued to those qualified.

6. Number of guests per member is limited to 10 at any one time, unless prior arrangements have been made with the Club Manager.

SWIMMING

1. Children under 13 years of age will not be allowed to swim in the deep end of the pool without a parent or adult unless they can pass the Swim & Safety test. This consists of being able to swim the width of the pool.

2. All children who are in diapers must wear plastic pants with snug fitting elastic waist and leg bands while in the baby pool or the main pool.

3. The lifeguards are to be obeyed at all times. Swimmers are to leave the pool immediately upon a signal from the lifeguard.

4. Adult swim time will be each hour from 10 minutes to the hour until the hour. During this time only those persons 18 and older will be allowed in the pool. During this time only one child, 6 and under, per adult may be brought into the shallow end of the pool.

5. Admission to the pool may be refused to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflammation of the eye, or infectious diseases.

6. Spitting of water will not be allowed.

7. No swimming will be allowed in the diving area.

8. Playing is not allowed on the ladders. Hanging on the ropes and buoys is prohibited.

9. No back flips or back dives are allowed off the edge of the pool.

10. Running, pushing, rough play and dunking will not be allowed.

11. Swimmers must wear suitable bathing suits or trunks. No cut-offs of any kind are allowed.

12. Swim toys may be furnished by members, but their use must be approved by the lifeguard.
13. During normal pool operating hours there will be no diving from the swim team dive blocks.

VOLLEYBALL

1. Volleyball use is on a sign-up basis. Members using the court should cooperate with other members in their right to use the court and should allow others to join in play.
2. When demand is heavy, court use is restricted to one hour per team.
3. Balls can be checked out at the concession stand by any member 13 years and older. Members failing to return a ball will be billed for the cost of a new one.
4. Balls going over the fence must be promptly retrieved.
5. Throwing of sand or abuse of the net is prohibited.
6. Anyone playing on the volleyball court must shower before entering the pool.

PICKNICKING

1. Members are allowed to bring their own food or drink. No glass bottles or other breakable items will be allowed.
2. Gas Grills are provided by the Club and are available to any adult member, on a first come, first serve basis, at no charge. Members are responsible for cleaning the grill after use.
3. All trash must be disposed of properly.
4. Alcoholic beverages may be consumed on the premises provided they are consumed from plastic or metal containers. No one, member or guest, who is under the age of 21, may consume alcohol on the Club property.

PRIVATE PARTIES-AFTER HOURS

1. Private, after hours party reservations must be made with the Club Manager at least 2 weeks in advance. An application form needs to be picked up and returned 2 weeks prior to the event. The Club Manager reserves the right to refuse permission.
2. A fee, based on the number of guests attending the party will be charged for rental of the Club. This fee will be determined annually.
3. The host/hostess must be a dues paying member and be present at the party. Non-members residing with Foxridge may attend private parties.
4. Hours allowed for private parties are between 8-10:30 p.m. on weekdays and 8-11 p.m. on weekends. The member who is having the party is responsible for paying the lifeguards on duty an hourly rate determined annually. The number of lifeguards will be based on the number of attendees at the party. All clean-up must be done by those attending the party so that facility is totally vacated by 11:00 PM on the weekends. The lifeguard fee is in force until the facility is vacated. Setup for any private party can only begin 1/2 hour before the pool closes. Guests for any private party will not be allowed into the pool area until pool closes.
5. A damage and cleaning deposit, determined annually, must be paid at the time the party application is turned in, with no exceptions. Barring any problems, this deposit will be refunded within 24 hours. Cancellations must be made 24 hours in advance.
6. If alcohol will be served, or if guests will be bringing their own, the host/hostess must submit, with their application, a certificate of liability insurance. This shows that their homeowner insurance policy has liability coverage.

PRIVATE PARTIES-DURING NORMAL CLUB HOURS

1. Private parties, held during normal Club operating hours, are limited to a maximum of 15 people. These include children's birthday parties, family reunions, etc.
2. Reservations must be made one week in advance. Forms are available at the front desk.
3. No more than two of these parties can be held on any given day.
4. Other than normal guest fees, there is no charge for these parties

FOXRIDGE SWIM & RACQUET CLUB BABY WADING POOL RULES

The baby wading pool is limited to children 5 years old and under.

Parents must watch their toddlers at all times, children must not be left unattended.

Large, inflatable pool toys are not allowed.

No kickboards allowed.

Parents, older siblings or babysitters are not allowed in the pool.

No pool deck chairs in the pool.

No food or drink allowed in the pool.

DIVING BOARD RULES

No diving off the side of the board

No running dives

Only 1 bounce on the board is permitted

Only 1 person at a time on the board and ladder

No diving off the board until previous diver has cleared the diving area

No back dives or inward dives

No dives from a sitting position

Only one (1) forward flip allowed

No twist dives allowed
